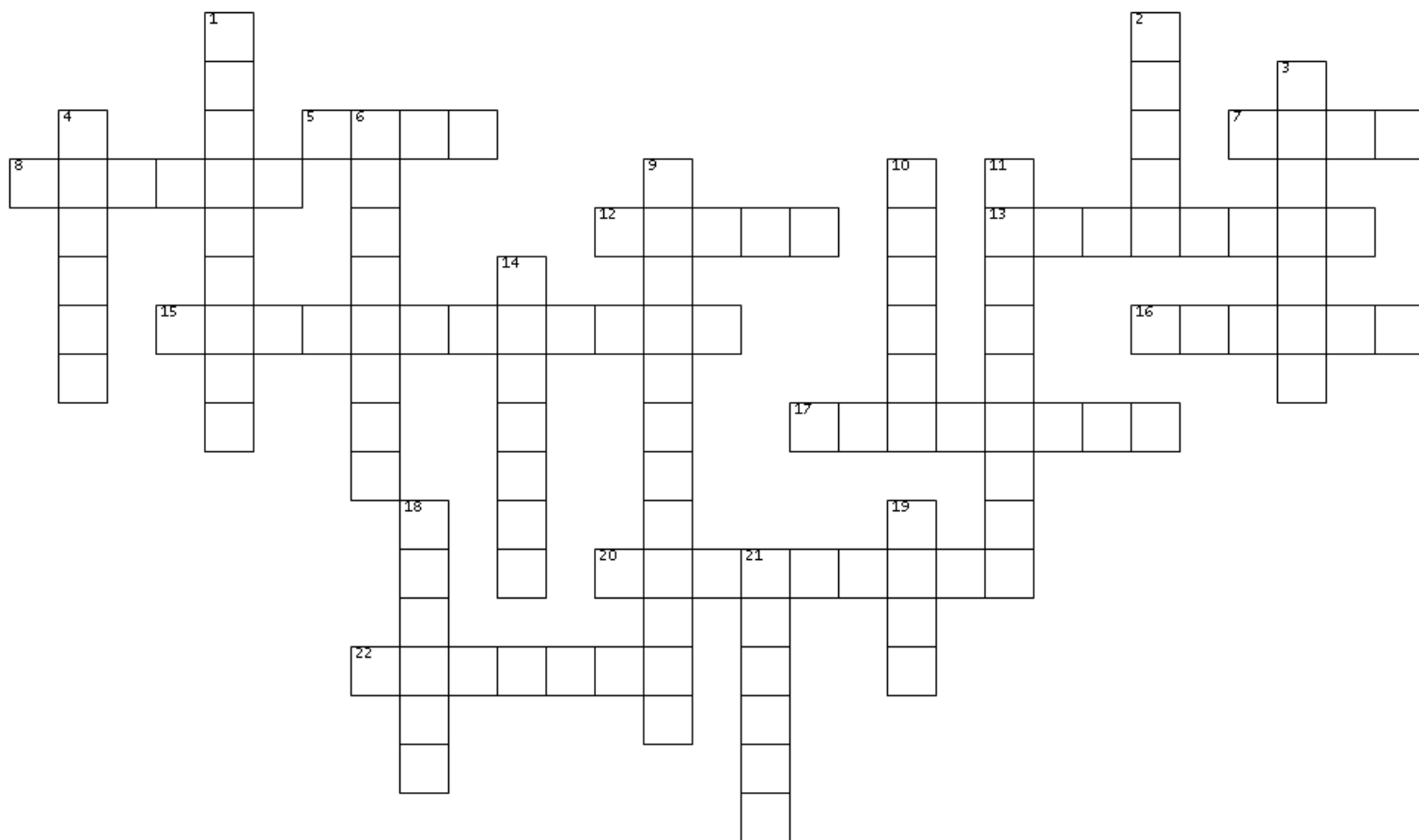


Instructions
